January: Harbin Ice and Snow Festival

The world's largest snow and ice carnival "Harbin International Ice and Snow Festival" will be held on January 5th every year! February: Valentine's Day, Hokkaido Festival, Mardi Gras, Venice Carnival, Rio Carnival

On behalf of the pink romantic Western Valentine's Day in February, it is a good opportunity to travel with the other half. Traveling is a wonderful thing. You can get to know each other better when you travel and find that you are not suitable for each other. Asia has the most representative Sapporo Snow Festival in winter in Japan. Each year, more than 300 large-scale ice sculptures are piled up on the theme, so that visitors come to enjoy the snow. In addition, from Ash Wednesday to Easter Day, the Christian is a 40-day fasting period (Lent), during which no egg or milk products are eaten, so it is called Tuesday before the start of the fasting period. During the custom of the period, local carpenters used to work on the wooden bench decorated with dolls to set up the candlelight when they were working on winter nights; until March 19, the carpenter guarded the birthday of San José, and it was also the spring coming. The burning of the Taiwanese in addition to the old cloth has evolved into a burning idol. During the annual fire festival, more than 500 statues spread throughout the city of Valencia.



There are also dolls showing, marching, offering flowers to the Virgin and the selection of the Queen of Fire and the Princess, in addition to the statue of the first prize. In the museum collection, other statues will be concentrated in the government square on the night of March 19, and will be burned at midnight to announce the end of the day of the fire festival. Ireland on the other side celebrates the largest annual festival, the Guardian Saint of St. Patrick's Day. Every March 17th, everyone will wear green-related clothes accessories, wear a clover with a religious interpretation of the Trinity, and also symbolize the lucky lucky grass ornaments. Watch the parade on the streets of Dublin, the capital, and render the whole country. Green and green, the river will be dyed green, where you can see the unique and charming Ireland.

April: Holly Festival, Water Festival, King's Day

The April of the coming of spring is also the New Year of the two \nationalities. The Holi Festival of the Indian New Year is the most colorful festival in the world. The streets and alleys are in a state of madness, with colorful powders and natural stains for spraying the liquid dyed with flour and water. The caste system strictly adhered to in peacetime has become unimportant in front of this festival. The Songkran Festival was originally called "nothing" in Thailan (Songkran), which is the same as the word "Shan Han". It is called "Thingyan" in Myanmar. It is derived from Sanskrit and means "running." The Songkran Festival is named after the fact that Southeast Asians believe that the sun is turning into the first house in the zodiac constellation, the Amur Palace (from Indian astrology), which represents the beginning of the new year. But the sun into the Amur Palace should be March, the holiday is scheduled to be in mid-April is a calculation error, but people have no intention of overturning the concept of customary conventions, and Thailand now adopts the Gregorian calendar, the Songkran Festival is scheduled for April of the annual calendar. The evening of the summer solstice is more lively than during the day, with folk concerts and ballet performances celebrating the unique landscape.





France will start with the music festival (La Fête de la Musique) and enjoy free music and street performances on Paris night on June 21st. In the early summer, the season of lavender blooms, South France Provence has the most famous "Lavender Road", the entire lavender field of different shades of purple waves layer up and down, feeling deeply surrounded by lavender flowers, If you don't want to fly to the far south, you can go to Japan's Hokkaido, near Taiwan, to experience the same beautiful lavender fields.

July: Avignon Festival, Bull Festival, Summer Discount Season

In Spain, the Bull Run Festival is held from July 6th to 14th each year to commemorate San Fermin's protection of the sages and bullfighting.
